SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Applicant's parents must be members of the Annunciation Orthodox Church in Dayton, Ohio for at least two consecutive years; beginning no later than the calendar year of the applicant's junior year in high school.

AIF Scholarship Criteria and Guidelines

Point System

Eligibility and consideration requirements:

- Students obtain points from three categories: <u>Spiritual</u>, <u>Fellowship</u> and <u>Service</u>.
- 50 total points must be obtained from the Spiritual category.
- The remaining points are at the student's discretion.
- Points are cumulative over the student's junior and senior years of high school only.
- 100 points are required to receive 100% of the scholarship award with at least 15 points being earned in the spirituality category in each year.
- Points below 100 are eligible for a partial scholarship award as follows:
 - o 95 points = 95% of the scholarship
 - o 90 points = 90% of the scholarship
 - 85 points = 85% of the scholarship
 - o 75 points = 75% of the scholarship
 - No scholarships are awarded below 75 points

• Completed application due: MAY 1st of your HS graduation year

CATEGORIES and POINTS

SPIRITUAL CATEGORY

- A) Sunday Church Attendance@ Annunciation Church Dayton, Ohio: A log will be kept at the candle stand where junior and senior students will sign in. A parent will not be permitted to sign in a student. Students are expected to sign the log-in prior to the reading of the Epistle, or, in the case of services without an Epistle, not later than 15 minutes after the start of the service. *No attendance will be awarded if the student arrives after this time. At the end of the month, all records will be reported to the parish priest and AIF. Church attendance is calculated for the entire year: (beginning on the Ecclesiastical New Year September 1 through August 31).
 - a. Junior Year: September September (50 Sundays)Senior Year: September End of May (30 Sundays)
 - **b.** If student attends Sunday Divine Liturgy at another parish, they must supply a bulletin from that parish or their parent must write a letter of testimony. (MAX: 3 times per year)
 - **c.** If student attends Sunday Divine Liturgy on-line, their parent must write a letter of testimony. (MAX: 3 times per year)
 - d. Students can attend various weekday services through the course of the year. Including:
 - i. Any Divine Liturgy
 - ii. Friday Night Salutations
 - iii. Paraklesis services 1-15 August
 - iv. Any Holy Week Service
 - v. Lenten Great Compline (usually Monday evening during Great Lent)
 - e. 100%-81% attendance=20 points

80% attendance = 15 points

70% attendance = 10 points

60% attendance = 5 points

No points awarded below 60% attendance

B) <u>Catechism School Attendance @ Annunciation Church Dayton, Ohio:</u>

The 11th and 12th grade teacher will keep an attendance log for each class. Catechism school attendance records begin with the first day of class and end on the last day of class each year; attendance records are kept on a digital spreadsheet.

- **a.** No attendance will be awarded for early dismissal (except medical emergencies)
- **b.** No penalty for attending a memorial (student must notify teacher).
- **c.** 100%-81% attendance = 20 points

80% attendance = 15 points

70% attendance = 10 points

60% attendance = 5 points

No points awarded below 60% attendance

- C) Spirituality class: In-person and taught by the parish priest. (4 pts.)
- **D)** <u>Oratorical Festival:</u> The Oratorical Festival Chairman will keep a participation record.
 - a. Points awarded (15 pts.)
- **E)** Church Choir: Active participation; as defined by the choir director with attendance prior to the Epistle Reading (5 pts.)
- **F)** Altar Server: Active participation; as defined by the parish priest with attendance prior to the Epistle Reading (5 pts.)
- G) <u>Narthex Server:</u> Active participation; as defined by the parish priest with attendance prior to the Epistle Reading (5 pts.)
- H) Metropolis/Archdiocese Camp Participation:
 - **a.** Attending MDSC, St. Nicholas Camp or Ionian Village (10 pts.)
- I) Orthodox Theological Education:
 - a. I.E. CrossRoad Summer Institute (20 pts.)

J) Participation in the Life of the Church:

- i. Reading prayers in church during Lent/Holy Week
 - 1. Salutations prayers (1 pt.)
 - 2. Palm Folding (1 pt.)
 - 3. Holy Wednesday Service participation (4 pt.)
 - 4. Holy Thursday Vigil (4 pts)
 - 5. Great Friday prayer reading (1 pt.)
 - **6.** Holy Saturday prayer reading (1 pt.)
 - 7. Agape service: multi-lingual reading of the Gospel (1 pt.)
- **K)** Religious Retreat Attendance: Proof of participation must come from the parish priest (5 pts.)
- **L)** <u>Book Club Participation:</u> Read assigned book(s) and participate in group discussion. Proof of participation must come from the parish priest (1 pt. per session attended)

FELLOWSHIP CATEGORY

GOYA:

 Juniors and seniors must attend at least 50% of the GOYA meetings (5pts.)

GOYA OFFICER:

Juniors and seniors who hold an office (5pts.)

Dayton GOYA Basketball Tournament:

Attendance at the Friday Night Welcome- Vesper service, service project
 (5 pts.)

Weekend participation: attend games, dance, Divine Liturgy (5 pts.)

GOYA Coffee Hours: The GOYA advisors will keep a participation record

• Participation in set-up, serve and clean-up at ALL coffee hours (5 pts.)

Greek Folk Dancing:

- Attending practices and performances throughout the year:
 - Greek Festival (10 pts.)
 - March 25th (5 pts.)
